## 1. The Promoter

## 2. Eligibility

The competition is global and open to people of all ages and nationalities. There is no lower age limit for entry. We reserve the option to ask for proof of age as winning competitors under the age of 16 may be requested to prove they have the consent of a parent or guardian.

Should prospective entrants be in any doubt as to their eligibility, then confirmation from the Promoter should be sought by emailing [dancegrist2@gmail.com](mailto:dancegrist2@gmail.com).

Entrants under the age of 18 at the closing date of the competition must gain the permission of a parent or guardian to enter the competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant (and the entrant's parent or guardian) to ensure that they have read and will abide by these rules. By submitting an entry, each entrant (and the entrant's parent or guardian) agrees to these rules, that their entry complies with these rules, and that they will be liable to the Promoter and their licensees in respect of any damages or losses incurred as a breach of the Rules.

## 3. Submission Rules

This is an Instagram-only competition.

Entrants must:

1. Follow DanceGr.ist on Instagram
2. Create an Instagram Story in any format they want. In it they should say or show why they like the Dance Grist app.
3. Tag @DanceGr.ist and #1515s on their story

All images should be the work of the entrant.

By entering, the entrant confirms that the work is their own, that it is original, that the copyright belongs to them and that the entrant indemnifies the organisers against any action that may be taken if this turns out not to be the case.

Individuals can post as many entries as they like, can win up to 3 times if they share their submissions on their Instagram Stories and up to 6 times if they also share their submissions on their Instagram feed.

#### **4. Prizes**

Judges will award 15 prizes of £15 by paypal or of a £15 Amazon voucher, depending on local laws and the entrant's preference.

Each of the £15 winners will have the opportunity to compete for a top prize of £150.

Winners will be notified following the completion of the final judging process and will be formally announced on the Dance GRiST Instagram account and website or alternative time and media at the Promoter's discretion.

#### **5 Competition Judging**

The competition opens at 12.01am BST June 22<sup>nd</sup> and closes at 12.01 BST July 22<sup>nd</sup>.

A shortlist will be shared on the DanceGr.ist Instagram feed during the competition and stories after which winners will be selected based on originality, relevance and imagination.

The £15 winners will be contacted at the end of the competition on July 20th 2018 when they will be invited to submit entries to compete for the final prize of £150.

#### **6. Copyright and permissions**

All submissions MUST be the total and exclusive work of the entrant and may not include any element that is the copyright of another. The Copyright for each image entered will remain with its respective entrant. By entering the Competition and submitting your story or stories, you hereby grant Dance GRiST a non-exclusive, irrevocable license to use your photograph(s) for any purpose connected with the Competition, including (but not limited to), promoting the Competition within online media, the inclusion of a screen shot within printed matter promoting the Competition, and other merchandise, display at exhibitions, use in press, promotional and marketing materials, social media networks and for the promotion of any future photographic competition in both print and online media. All work will be credited to the entrant where used.
